### **Washington County Historical Society**

Located in West Bend, Wisconsin, the Washington County Historical Society is a nonprofit organization that is supported by contributions and memberships. The Society serves to promote an educational program by bringing a better understanding and appreciation to the citizens of Washington County for their history, heritage, and natural environment.

The Society operates three historic sites within Washington County. These sites include the Old Courthouse Museum, the Old Jailhouse Museum, and St. Agnes Convent. The Society operates within the Old Courthouse Museum.

Saturdays: 9am - 1pm

Sundays\*: 1pm - 4:30pm

### **Milwaukee Art Museum**, 30 miles.

Open 7 days a week, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. except Thursday, open until 8 p.m. Closed Thanksgiving and Christmas. Non-member adults \$8, seniors \$6, students \$4, children 12 and under free when accompanied by an adult. Milwaukee County residents, free general admission Monday and Saturday mornings, 10 a.m. to noon (not valid with any other discounts or special events).

### **Milwaukee Public Museum**, 30 miles.

The Milwaukee Public Museum is open 9 a.m.-5 p.m. daily; closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and July 4. Admission: Adults (16-61) \$8, Seniors (62+) \$7, Children (3-15) \$5.50, Children 2 and under are free.
